- Experience with HTML, JavaScript, CSS, Python
- Experience with SQL, as well as using SQL-based queries from within programming languages
- Experience with Xamarin mobile application development (preferred)
- Experience with Selenium web scraping (preferred)

- Experience with ASP.NET MVC Framework (preferred)
- Familiarity with Azure or other PaaS (preferred)
- Familiarity with version control tools such as Git
- Willingness to learn and take on other responsibilities as they arise
